Fair Housing Is Your Right. Use It.

It is illegal for a housing provider to prohibit service animals, charge a fee for service animals, or ask for a deposit for service animals. Landlords must make reasonable accommodations for persons with disabilities, such as allowing for service animals without charging a fee.
