# **DE Voting During COVID-19 DATES TO KNOW**

The following dates are the most current elections dates pursuant to fifteenth modification of the Declaration of a State of Emergency for the State of Delaware due to a public threat.

- Delaware Presidential Primary Election: moved to **July 07, 2020**
- Registration Deadline for Presidential Primary: moved to **June 13, 2020**
- **\*\*\*Delaware will mail all registered Presidential Primary voters an Absentee Ballot Application\*\*\* (Voters may also request Absentee Ballot Online)**
- Delaware Presidential General Election: **11/03/2020**
- Deadline to Register for Presidential General Election: **10/10/2020.**
- Deadline to Request Absentee Ballot for General Election: **10/30/2020. Submission Deadline: 8 p.m. 11/03/2020.**
- All elections for school board members for any district scheduled to be conducted on May 12, 2020: moved to **June 16, 2020**
- If not cancelled already by a board of education, any referendum election in a Delaware school district, scheduled before May 15, 2020 (and about the local school board, school taxes, contraction or bonds), is cancelled and will be rescheduled by the school district's board of education.
- Municipal (city/town) elections scheduled to be held on/ before May 15, 2020, pursuant to a municipality's charter or municipal code, are cancelled and will be rescheduled by the municipality.

**Ballot Processing Changes:** Due to the State of Emergency, the earliest time the Department may begin the processing of Absentee Ballots is 10 days before the election.

# Voting Options during COVID-19

## Voting outside the polling place options:

**Absentee Ballot:** because of COVID-19 the Governor ordered that any voter may use absentee ballots or electronic voting, **MEANING YOU CAN VOTE ONLINE!** All registered voters can request an absentee ballot by selecting "sick or physically disabled" due to the COVID crisis.

**Deadlines for Absentee Applications: July 3, 2020**

**In Person:** Before 12 Noon the day before the election (July 6th for the July 7th primary).

**By Mail or Online:** 4 days before Primary Election Day (July 3 for the July 7 primary).

**Absentee Ballot must be received by Dept. of Elections by:**  
8 p.m. July 7, 2020

### ID NEEDED FOR IN-PERSON VOTING?

**You are not required to show ID to vote in person in Delaware, but bring one of the following if you have it to speed up the process:**

- A current photo ID
- Signed social security card, polling place card, or vehicle registration
- A similar document that identifies you by photo or signature
